The scholarship will be funded up to \$1000.00, to a student enrolled in a college or university in Oregon or Washington, to assist in funding a worthy archaeological project. This scholarship was established in 1973 to honor the memory of a man who was an enthusiastic supporter of archaeology.

Applications should include a brief biographical sketch of the applicant, a statement of financial need, a description of the project to be carried out, an accompanying letter of recommendation from a professor in his/her department, contact phone number and contact address. The deadline for receipt of applications is February 1, 2015.
